Color matching between a sample and the final product



It can be difficult to match the exact color of a sample to the final product due to the unique nature of wood materials combined with the application of paints or stains.

At Maibec, while we strive to faithfully reproduce the same shade across production runs, we have a **minimum and maximum tolerance for variations from the production reference**. Even if you have a sample number, the color is still produced according to the tolerance scale.

When you buy Maibec natural-tone siding or semi-transparent stained shingles, please keep this tolerance scale in mind.

You could receive a product that is either lighter or darker than the sample, but still within the acceptable range. We aim to provide as much detail as possible to help you make an informed decision. Below are examples* illustrating the difference between minimum and maximum tolerances:
